Entry Method:

On-line at www.tennisontario.com

- Click on "Player Information"
- Select "Tournament Registration"
- Input required information: **First & Last Name; User Name & Password**
- Select appropriate Tournament i.e. **2010 U12 Outdoor Junior Provincials******
Screen will refresh, then "check" appropriate box

i.e. **U12 Junior Provincial Closed Championships - Boys Singles - U12 - \$95.00**

- Once the appropriate box (above) has been checked off, registrants will be able to submit a valid credit card for payment, Visa or Master Card.
- Confirmation e-mail from the OTA should be received

- OTA Fax: 416-514-1112. Use a standard tournament entry form & provide all relevant information. Must provide a valid Visa or Master Card # with Expiry Date**

In-person at the OTA office

- Must be made at the OTA office during regular Business hours 9 am - 5 pm**

**All faxed or in-person entries are subject to a non-refundable \$15.00 administrative fee.

IMPORTANT NOTES to enter Provincial Qualifying:

Players cannot enter the Qualifying event directly as Qualifying acceptance is only determined once all players have entered the Main Draw.

All players who wish to participate in the Junior Provincials and the Qualifying event **must** enter the Main draw(s) of Provincials as explained above.

Acceptance Criteria & Lists:

Acceptance criteria into the Provincial Championships Main Draw

Boys: Main draw size is 40

- Top 32 entries based on Provincial ranking as of entry deadline receive Main Draw entry
- Remaining players are placed in the Qualifying event for the 8 spots in the Main Draw. Each qualifying event is played down to the Quarterfinals.

Girls: Main draw size is 32

- Top 24 entries based on Provincial ranking as of entry deadline receive Main Draw entry
- Remaining players are placed in the Qualifying event for the 8 places in the Main Draw. Each qualifying event is played down to the quarterfinals.

Main Draw and Qualifying Acceptance lists will be posted on the OTA website under “Tournament News” or “Junior News“ Fri. JUNE 11 by 5 pm.

N.B. It is each player’s responsibility to ensure that his/her name appears on one of the acceptance lists.

Qualifying Information:

Once a player’s name appears on the Qualifying list, he/she must be prepared to play the Qualifying event at the designated site, Fri. June 19 – Sun. 21, 2009.

Note: the Qualifying tournament fee is a separate entry fee payable at the host club site.

Any players who play the Qualifying, but fail to qualify will be refunded their \$95 entry fee. Refund process will begin during the Provincials. Please allow sufficient turnaround time. Any faxed or “in-person” payments will NOT be refunded the \$15.00 admin fee. However, the \$95 entry fee will be refunded in full.
