



TEAM ONTARIO SELECTION CRITERIA: 2021 JUNIOR NATIONALS

All players interested in competing for Team Ontario must be registered competitors of the OTA in good standing at the time of selection. Participation in the 2021 Outdoor Nationals will be determined by the following criteria:

1. All Team Ontario players must be Canadian citizens or landed immigrants with a minimum residency of six months in the province.
2. Tennis Canada determines the number of allocation spots in each category for all provincial associations.
For 2021, Ontario has 10 spots for boys and girls in each of the U12, U14, U16 and U18 Outdoor Nationals.
 - In addition to the “base” allocations from Tennis Canada, additional spots for National Tennis Centre (Montreal) players have been reserved for Ontario players.
 - Tennis Canada may also grant Nationals allocation spots to players in the Regional Training Centre; National Junior Training Program (at Aviva).
3. Remaining allocation spots go to players who qualify through the OTA Selection Tournaments (see below).

WILD CARDS

Wild cards may be granted at the discretion of the OTA selection committee. Only players with a National or International profiles will be considered. Any wild cards awarded will come from the original allocation of Team Ontario spots (10).

Wild card requests must be submitted to Kartik Vyas (Manager, Player Development) 30 days prior to the start of the Junior Nationals. Wild cards will be awarded based on a player’s National and International profile and/or other factors worthy of consideration.

NATIONAL SELECTION TOURNAMENTS

Players with the best combination of points as described in the table below receive the remaining allocation spots, as described above. In order to gain selection points, players must win at least one match in that event. For this year, one National Selection tournament and the Outdoor Junior Closed Provincials will factor into the selection of Ontario players for the Outdoor Junior Nationals.

***** The Ontario Junior Closed has a mandatory feed-in singles consolation and due to date changes and court accommodation, doubles will NOT be offered for the 2021 Outdoor Junior Provincial Closed event.**
