Events Description

- 4 – 1 day Junior Team Tennis Events
- U14/U18 Girls Doubles All Stars division – Saturday June 1 at Aviva Centre
- U14/U18 Boys Doubles All Stars division – Saturday June 1 at Aviva Centre
- U14/U18 Mixed Doubles All Stars division – Sunday June 2 at Aviva Centre
- U10/U12 Future Stars Doubles division – Sunday June 2 at Aviva Centre
- Round Robin Format – no elimination in early rounds

Eligibility

- Open to Girls and Boys U10, U12, U14 & U18 - as of Jan 1, 2019
- U14/U18 – Each fixture consists of one U14 doubles and one U18 doubles match – one boy and one girl per doubles team for Mixed division.
- U10/12 – Each fixture consists of one U10 doubles and one U12 doubles match - gender neutral.
- Team consists of 4 to 6 players, minimum 4 – substitution allowed between matches.
- Must be a member of an OTA or ICTA club.
- All players must bring a completed and signed waiver form to the registration desk.
- Full team rosters including the team captain and all players date of birth must be submitted prior to registration. To access on-line registration form, click [here](#).
- Each player can only play for 1 team on the same day. The same player can play on a team on Saturday and a team on Sunday.
- Players must arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the fixture as per OTA Rule #16 on punctuality.



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Rules of Play

- **Boxed round robin format**
- **Number of teams per box and number of boxes will be determined by total entries**
- **Box allocation will be random draw – some seeding will take place across boxes**
- **Round Robin results will determine flights for knockout round - no eliminations from Round Robin portion**
- **Afternoon results will determine final flights standings**
- **“Fixture” consists of 2 doubles matches – one U14 and one U18 or one U10 and one U12**
- **U14/U18 – 45 minutes or pro set to 8 games, whichever comes first, (no ad, receivers choice). Only complete games count.**
- **U10/U12 – 45 minutes or pro set to 8 games, whichever comes first, (no ad, receivers choice). Only complete games count.**
- **Teams will play matches against all other teams in box**
- **Total games for in all matches will determine final position in boxes**



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Rules of Play – con'd

- In case of tie in total games won in round robin portion, position in knockout round will be determined by head to head results, then total games against, then by coin toss
- Substitutions permitted between matches – no mid-match substitutions
- At least one player from each doubles team in round robin portion must be available to play in the knock out rounds
- Rules and scoring are subject to modification based on number of teams entered, weather and time constraints
- All players are expected to abide by the [OTA Code of Conduct Rules](#)
