



Section 1.01 RESOURCES FOR FACILITIES MANAGEMENT

Although the OTA offers information to support facilities management your best resource is likely to be other clubs in your region who have used the services or had problems with facilities management. We suggest you take advantage of OTA programs such as Presidents' Day and your Regional organization to build a network of club executives who can help with recommendations and references when you need facility work done.



Funding

One of the major issues with upgrades to a facility is funding. Many clubs have received funding from the Ontario Trillium Foundation for facility improvements.
