What is the NIKE Transition Tour Circuit?

The NIKE Transition Tour Circuit is designed for players wishing to compete beyond the Future Stars and Rogers Rookie Tours.

- ★ All tournaments involved are sanctioned by the OTA.
- ★ 2-star level National Bank Ranking points are awarded to participants in the tournaments.
- ★ A leaderboard for each category will be maintained by the OTA throughout the duration of this circuit.
  - ❖ the Leaderboard will consist of the culmination of ranking points earned from these tournaments as per [nationalbankrankings.com](http://nationalbankrankings.com) or see the following table:

## Tournament Specifics

---

Entry Fee: \$60 / \$70 (indoors)

Entry Deadline: Two weeks prior to the start of the tournament dates.

Draw Date: 5-7 days after entry deadline closes.

Surface: hard or clay, indoor or outdoor.

## Eligibility

---

- ★ Players must be under the given age category as of Jan 1, 2023, in order to compete in that age group.
- ★ All entrants must hold a valid OTA membership.
- ★ **Ranking Policy: Players must be ranked 31st or lower in the registered age group in Ontario.**

## Rules of Play

---

- ★ Scoring Format: Best of three tie-break sets, no-ad scoring, 10-point match tiebreak for the third set.  
Consolation: 8-game pro-set, winning margin of 2 games. 7-point tiebreak played at 7 games all.
- ★ Format: Single elimination with first round or first match loser consolation
- ★ Draws and match format may be modified in the event of inclement weather or any unforeseeable circumstances.
